

SBN-Sticky

This program is provided AS-IS. I hope it will be useful to you but I can not guarantee that. You are free to distribute this program as long as this 'documentation' is supplied as well.

1. Features

SBN-Sticky is a small and easy to use onscreen-noticeboard.

Usage is simple: Run the program, write messages. No installation necessary. Messages are saved when the program terminates (saved to file "pos.dat" in the program directory). Next time you start the program the saved messages are restored to the window.

That's about it.

Some more features: The window can be resized by clicking on its border and moved by clicking on its top.

If you right-click in the main window, a dialogue will appear:

Although this should be pretty self-explanatory a few words:

- ☞ **Autostart STICKY** : If you choose this option, SBN-Sticky will automatically start at WINDOWS startup (surprising, isn't it?). If your curious how this works please read "Technical Details" further down.
- ☞ **Always on top** : As one could expect, this option causes SBN-Sticky to stay on top of all other windows, a feature that can be quite useful from time to time.
- ☞ **Colour Options** : Just have a guess what these options do.... Your favourite colours are saved along the other data.

2. Technical Details

A file called "pos.dat" is created in the program directory. It contains the messages as well as window size and position.

If you choose the 'Autostart' option two registry keys are created:

HKEY_CURRENT_USER, Software\ShamanBenefitNetwork\Sticky: Contains the program path.

HKEY_CURRENT_USER, Software\Microsoft\Windows\CurrentVersion\Run, SBN Sticky: Responsible for the autostart.

If you uncheck the 'Autostart' option these keys are deleted.

You can run several instances of this program but only the messages of the last instance are saved. In general theres no need for several instances because you can make the window as large as necessary.

System Requirements: Tested on WinXP and Win2k. Will probably run under Win 9x/Me. Will probably not run under Win3.11 or previous Versions.
